Dear Members,

On behalf of CSI, Delhi Chapter, it is my proud privilege to welcome you all in the Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of CSI, Delhi Chapter. I, as the Hon. Secretary, take this opportunity to present the Annual Report to this August House, highlighting the major activities/ events during the year 2017-2018.

The elected M.C. assumed the charge on 11th April, 2017. AGM was convened on 09-09-2017. The following events and meetings were organized during the period of the year of 2017-2018.

1. **Conferences, Workshops, Orientation Programs at CSI Student Branch of CSI**

Delhi Chapters: Institutes like GTBIT, HMRITM, and other institutes with active involvement of MC CSI Delhi, Delhi State student coordinator and respective student branches. Some branches organized state student convention, some other organized national student convention. Some branches organized technical quiz programs and some other orientation programs. Officer bearers of CSI Delhi graced the occasion and guest of honors and highlighted the ongoing CSI activities at those forums.

2. **AGM – 9/09/2017**

Annual General Body Meeting was convened on 9th September, 2017 at ISI, Lodi Road, New Delhi. 19 Members attended the AGM. Detailed report is attached. Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Secretary were available with all the accounts & records on 7th September 2017 for our members seeking any clarifications. 3. **“Digital India & Challenges before CSI”:** The Technical talk was organized on 7.9.2018 at CSI Delhi Chapter Office from 6.30pm to 7.15pm.

4. **A Technical talk on "Knowledge Economics"** was held on 10th February, 2018 at 4.30 PM at CSI Delhi Chapter Office Pitampura Delhi. Sh. Abhijit Dutta Scientist F and Snr. Technical

Director, NIC, Govt. of India delivered the lecture on the topic as mentioned above. Many participants including student branch coordinators attended the meeting.



5. **“CSI National Student Convention”** Vivekananda Institute of Professional Studies (VIPS), New Delhi in collaboration with VIPS CSI Students’ Branch, New Delhi organized Nation Student Convention (NSC) on the theme of “Digital India” on 30th – 31st January 2018. NSC–2018 was aimed to inculcate professionalism and research aptitude amongst students’. Apart from the academic excellence, the motive behind the event was the overall development of the students. In the two-day convention a wide range of technical and non-technical events like Paper and Project Presentation, Programming, Singing, Dance, LAN Gaming, Dry Cooking, Street Play, Technical and Fandom Quiz, Web Designing, UX/UI etc. along with 24-hour Hackathon. All the events received a tremendous response in terms of participation. More than 2500+ participants from around 200 premier institutions from Allahabad, Banglore, Lucknow, Kanpur, Pune, Haryana, Faridabad, Noida, Greater Noida etc. participated in the event.

NSC-2018 commenced with the lighting of the lamp by a group of dignitaries as a sign of positivity. Prof. Rattan Sharma, Principal Director, VIPS formally welcomed all the dignitaries and participants from various institutes. He addressed the attendees and spoke about collaborating education with professional society and nurturing the country as a whole. Then, the mic was open for other dignitaries to share their experiences and enlighten the students. Dr. Alka Suri, Director, Defence Scientific Information and Documentation Centre (DESIDOC), Delhi, Honorable Chief Guest addressed the students and gave a brief about DRDO and DESIDOC through a presentation in which DRDO is becoming an important instrument for self-reliance of the nation and how some of the best innovations have come from the pool of scientists of DRDO. Further, she motivated the students to innovate and work with sincerity and dedication. Mr Jitender Panihar, Head of Human Resources, Healthkart, Delhi, addressed the gathering by saying that the world is changing. Artificial intelligence is bringing in tremendous change in future not just for HR, but the complete mankind in general. Artificial intelligence, according to him, means any data or system that can replace human intelligence. It is influencing change at every step with a click of a button. Artificial intelligence is revolutionizing every industry from agriculture to e-commerce. Artificial intelligence, he explained, can hence be used to evolve humankind. He is a one-man army with vivid skills & an untold story to inspire all. Seldom do we come across individuals who create a lasting impression by the sheer veracity of their thoughts and actions. Mr Amit Sharma, Co-founder at RENT IT BAE and Pronto IT Labs, Delhi shared his experience as a founder of a successful startup. Sir gave a brief about his online portal, RENT IT BAE, which is a place where fashion meets technology to create a unique rental market for the love of fashion. Also, they are India’s first and only company offering Fashion Subscription. Sir discussed the rapid growth of the world on the internet alone and even motivated the students to work something in this direction. Mr Kanishk Kumar, Sr. Associate Director – Enterprise Sales, Flock.co motivated students to work

in their field of interest for a bright future. Dr Sushila Madan, the State Student Coordinator for CSI, gave motivation to students for active participation in the event and wished for the success of the convention.



Dr Vinay Kumar, Dean, VSIT and Hon. Secretary, CSI-DC offered a vote of thanks to all dignitaries. He thanked all the invited guests and participants for gracing the occasion by their solemn presence and CSI for providing a platform to conduct such conventions. The inauguration was followed by an open discussion over tea. On the first day of the event a huge number of participants showed up to take part in the events like Paper and Project Presentation, NukkadNatak, 24 hrs Hackathon, Stage Play, Music, Lan Gaming, Character Dramatization etc.

6. **An inter College/Institutes IT Quiz** was organized at JIMS Rohini on **01.02.2018**. The Quiz Programme was very interesting and informative for the Students and other participants. Shri Akshay Kumar from JIMS and our MC Member, CSI Delhi Chapter was the Coordinator for this Programme.
7. **“Digital Judiciary – Technologies for Justice”**: The Delhi Chapter of CSI and CSI Div-1 in collaboration with IETE Delhi Centre, organized National Summit on the theme “Digital Judiciary – Technologies for Justice” on **25th February, 2018** at Seminar Hall of IETE Delhi centre. The summit was attended by experts from the fields of judiciary, Information Technology, Cyber Security, Digital recordings, Controlling cyber crimes and others and students with the total participation of more than 70. The Chief guest of the event was Hon’ble Mr. Justice Sh. Sunil Ambwani, Retired Chief Justice Rajasthan High Court and Ex. Chairman e-Committee, Supreme Court of India. The summit started at 10.AM with registration. Sh. Manoj Sethi, Chairman CSI-DC welcomed the Chief Guests and audiences. Er R S Chauhan, Chairman IETE and Sh. R. K. Vyas – Ex Hon. National Treasurer, CSI addressed the gathering. Chief guests addressed the audience on theme “e-committee: Present journey and the Road Map ahead”. He highlighted the importance of standardization of rules in High Courts for having common systems across all High Courts, he took the audience to the journey of computerization of courts and benefits of digital technology in judiciary. He further explained the requirement of having national data repository.

Mr. Tanmoy Chakrabarty, VP & Global Head GISU, TCS spoke on “e-courts-A holistic approach with total focus on outcomes” and highlighted integration of different public service through digital infrastructure. It was followed by a speech by Ms. Suhasini Gotamare, IA&AS on GSTN and its challenges. GSTN is still an evolving system and is going to be stabilized soon and it is the world’s first and largest system to handle such a volume of data across the length and width of the country. Mr. Manoj Kumar Tuli, Scientist F & Sr. Technical Director, NIC spoke “ICT enabled Justice Delivery System”, he elaborated on how the proceedings in the court both for judges and litigants and lawyers have become smooth and document availability better. Shri Anuj Agarwal, Chairman, Centre for Research on Cyber Crime & Cyber Law and co-convener SIG on Digital Judiciary and Cyber Laws of CSI spoke about the risks in online transactions and safety

tips. He narrated the legal challenges of apprehending cyber criminals because of their possibility of committing crimes from a different jurisdiction and lack of training and equipment with law enforcement agencies. ; Sh. Dhval Kotecha –Managing Director, Rapid Radio Solutions Pvt. Ltd. spoke about the use of RFID tags for physical file tracking for smooth court proceedings; Sh. Avinash J Trivedi – Vice President, Videonetics Technology Pvt. Ltd spoke about the challenges of low pixel quality cameras leading to challenges on courts not accepting the video digital evidence.; and Sh. Manoj Kumar Singh, AIIMS IT department talked about creating software tags for faster implementation of e-courts.

The meeting was compeered by Dr. Vinay Kumar, Hon. Secretary CSI-DC and DEAN VSIT, VIPS, Delhi. Finally, vote of thanks was given by Sh. B B Rishi, Hon. Secretary, IETE. The participant interacted with each other during lunch and the summit came to an end at around 3.30 PM.



8. **“CSI Foundation day”** was organized on 24th March, 2018 at JIMS Rohini. The function started at 3 PM. Prof M N Hoda, Director BVICAM and Dr. Pawan Gupta Director JIMS graced the occasion and enlightened the audience with the importance of the event and they highlighted the glorious journey of CSI all along these years since its foundation. The guest also highlighted “Role of Professional Societies in Changing Technological Paradigm of 21st Century”. The event was followed by a cultural program performed by students of CSI Students Branch. The cultural program was coordinated by Dr. Sushila Madam, Delhi State student coordinator. Prizes were distrusted to the branch participants.
